3. (social) community/organisation.

The organized community being a

4. sovereign state provides the natural person with a
5. legally valid identity.

A natural person is

6. occupant of a
7. geographical area. However, only through a legally valid identity is s/he recognized as
8. resident.

Please note, the sovereign state providing for the legally valid identity might differ from the sovereign state whose territory/jurisdiction the person actually occupies. When such a difference occurs, s/he formally is a foreigner in the latter state.
